Registration fees include compulsory and optional fees.

#### ➤ **Private Liability Insurance Policy**

In order to register you have to provide supporting documents regarding your Private Liability Insurance Policy.

If you are already insured, the terms "Garantie Responsabilité Civile Etudiante & Vie Privée" have to be explicitly specified on the supporting document.

If the contract doesn't cover the full academic year, you undertake to renew it in order to assure its coverage until the end of the academic year.

Students without any Liability Insurance Policy have the means to :

- take out a Liability Insurance Policy from a company they would choose ; in this case, the supporting document has to specify terms explicitly,
- take out a Liability Insurance Policy from one of the dedicated student insurance companies (*mutuelles étudiantes*).

#### ➤ **Social Security**

The contribution to Social Security services for students is **217 €**.

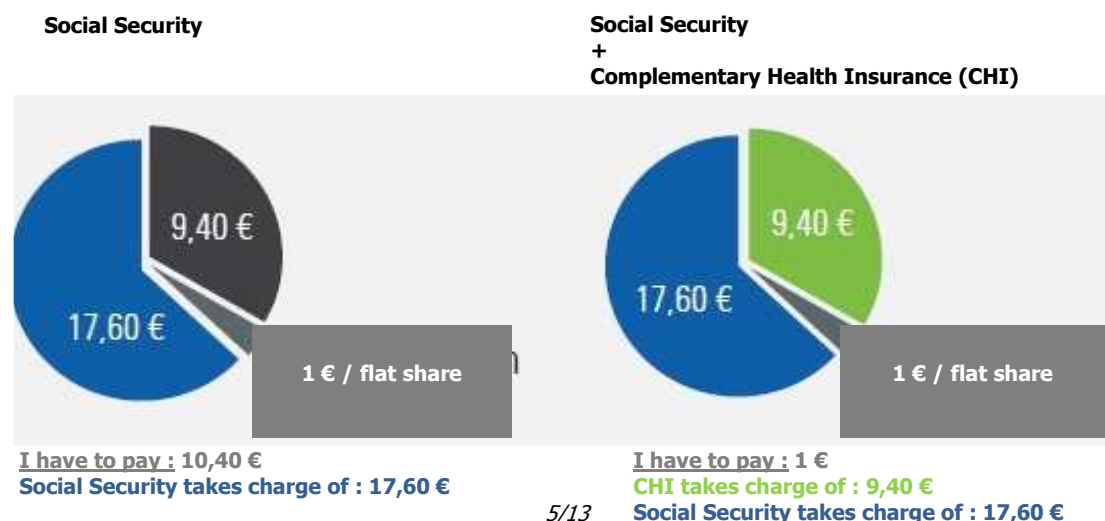

### **Optional fees**

#### ➤ **Complementary Health Insurance**

If you are not already insured and you wish to take out a complementary Health Insurance policy can choose one of the dedicated student insurance companies (*mutuelles étudiantes*), which offer a diversity of contracts (more detail is available in the booklets enclosed).

➔ **The registration payment :**

➤ **Online Registration :**

The online registration is determined by the payment of registration fees by credit card.

**CAUTION** : if you use a "E-credit-card", payment by instalments is not possible.

Cash payment : fees payment in full and at once when you enter your data.

3 instalments payment : authorised if total fees due exceed 300 euros, and if you enter your data on September 20 at the latest. The first instalment is immediate. The second and third direct debits will occur 30 days apart, from date to date.

➤ **Onsite Registration :**

Cash payment : payment possible either by credit card, or by transfer payment, or in cash if total is  $\leq 300$  euros, or by postal order if total is  $\geq 300$  euros and  $\leq 1500$  euros, or by cheque to the account of "*Agent comptable de l'Institut polytechnique de Grenoble*" (a single cheque, including all registration costs).

3 instalments payment : possible only by credit card to the debt collection Agency. Authorised if registration occurs on September 23 at the latest, and if total fees due exceed 300 euros. The first instalment is immediate, the second and third direct debits will occur 30 days apart, from date to date.

## SPECIAL CASES FOR FEE EXEMPTION AND REFUND

### ❖ **ENTITLEMENT TO EXEMPTION / REFUND**

Eligible public :

- the students with a need-based grant
- the students with a scholarship from the French State
- the students with a *Pupille de la Nation* status (war orphan status).

In order to benefit from the exemption by right, the following documents have to be provided as appropriate :

- final scholarship award notification for the current academic year,  
or
- conditional scholarship award notification for the current academic year,  
or
- the final notification related to the previous year.

As regards the two last situations, you'll have to provide the final scholarship award notification for the current academic year on November 30, 2016 at the latest.

If you are unable to provide any of the aforementioned supporting documents just as registering, you have to pay the required fees and apply for a refund as soon as you'll be able to provide an acceptable supporting document.

The fee exemption or refund only concerns tuition fee (except preventive medicine) and the subscription to Social Security (except for some categories of French government scholarship's recipients -> refer to the scholarship award notification).

### ❖ **FEES EXEMPTION FOR THE REFUGEES-STUDENTS**

Students who can prove that they are refugees-students or who are waiting for a decision about their status can apply for a fees exemption.

The fees exemption concerns school fees (except preventive medicine and social security contribution).

### ❖ **FEES EXEMPTION ON A DISCRETIONARY BASIS**

Students suffering from financial hardship can apply for a fees exemption or refund request, which will be examined on a case-by-case basis.

Such requests are based on the decision of the *administrateur général* (President) of the *Institut polytechnique de Grenoble* (Grenoble Institute of Technology) after having been examined by the Student Social Committee.

If you wish to apply for a fee exemption, you have to collect an application form from your School registrar's office without delay.

If you choose to register on line, you'll have the opportunity to ask for a refund.

The fee exemption or refund only concerns tuition fee (subscriptions to preventive medicine and Social Security are not subjected to refund).

Payment of required fees is to be made upon registration.

**CAUTION :** Affiliation with the Student Social Security involves an obligation to choose between LMDE and SMERRA as the paying centre.

(1) Students whose parents are in the specified category are considered to be insured in a personal capacity (*assurés à titre personnel*). They are affiliated with the Student Social Security scheme although they do not have to pay any fee. Health care expenses are refunded to them personally.

**NB :** For a 1<sup>st</sup> affiliation with the Student Social Security, the student has to provide to the chosen payment centre :

- a certificate from the referring doctor the student has chosen,
- bank account details

The VITALE card has to be updated each academic year **BEFORE THE 31<sup>st</sup> of DECEMBER**

### ➤ STUDENT NUMBER (8 digits, for registration renewal only)

Please write out the number featuring on last year's *Grenoble Institute of Technology* student ID card.

### ➤ FIRST REGISTRATION WITH A FRENCH HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION (Year following the award of the *Baccalaureate graduation*)

Please specify the year you first have been registered with a French higher educational institution.
