➔ **Contribution Vie Etudiante et de Campus (CVEC) = Tax for student life and campus**

The administrative registration depends on the **prior discharge** of the Contribution Vie Etudiante et de Campus (CVEC) [= Tax for student life and campus].

The CVEC is « *intended to facilitate the reception and the social, health, cultural and sport support towards students and to strengthen preventive actions and the health education set up for them* ».

So the purpose of this CVEC is to facilitate the development of services which can be useful for students in their daily life and in their institution as well as the development of benefits offered by the CROUS of their registration academy.

This CVEC is a **tax**, in opposition to a contribution ²²unlike a contribution, benefits are not derived on the basis of the discharge of this CVEC which consists in an involvement in the student life policy conducted as well by the registration institution as the CROUS.

The CVEC is **compulsory** and must be **settled every year**, in accordance with the following terms and conditions :

In case of registration in several trainings in the same academic year, the CVEC is due only upon the 1st registration. The payment or the justified exemption of the CVEC leads to the issue of a **CERTIFICATE** which is to be provided to the higher education institution in which the administrative registration is performed : this certificate is compulsory to complete and validate this administrative registration !

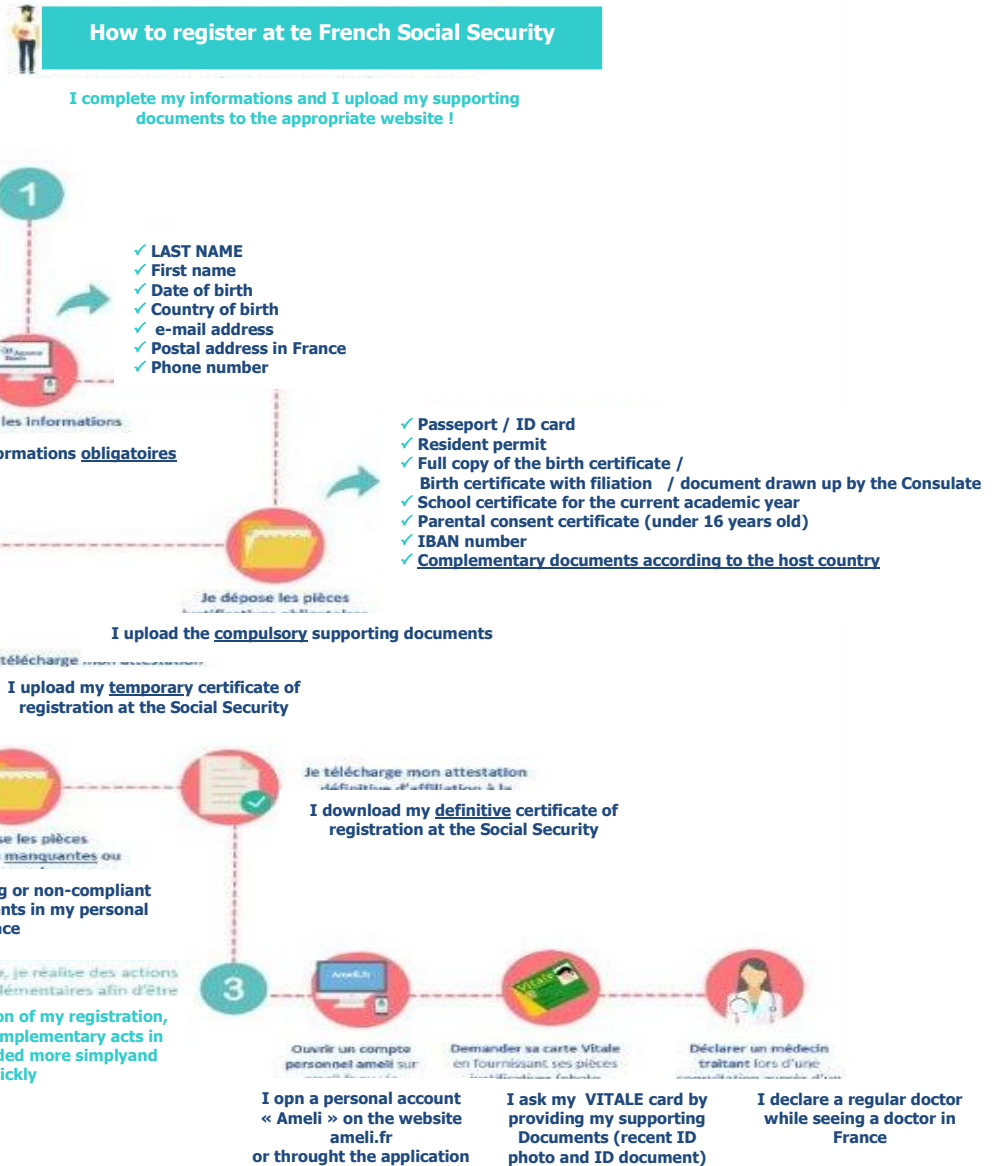
➔ **Health insurance cover : Social Security and Additional health insurance**

?? **Social Security**

In France, the healthcare system generally takes care of the most healthcare costs are generally covered by the healthcare system : the Social Security.
Subscription to the Social Security is free and compulsory.

Regarding the non-EU citizens, this subscription is compulsory for stays of more than 3 months, unless there is a bilateral agreement between France and your country of origin. This is the case for all member states of the European Union, European Economic Area, as well as Switzerland and Quebec : steps are thus to be taken before your arrival in France.

➤ **Additional health insurance (= Mutuelle complémentaire santé)**

The subscription to an additional health insurance is highly recommended to guarantee the complementary refund of your health expenses which wouldn't be covered by the Social Security.

- ▶ The use of a credit card is not unlimited. For each credit card, there is a **ceiling**, that is a withdrawal or payment threshold that you cannot exceed over a certain period of time ⇒ this ceiling has to be checked before the payment of the registration fees in order to prevent its blockage
- ▶ In the case of the use of a "E-credit card", the payment by installment is not possible
- ▶ Payment in installment (3 times): a credit card with a validity date greater than the last payment date is required
- ▶ Cash and cheques will not be accepted, except in exceptional situations when no other means of payment is possible.

➔ Fees exemption or refund

➤ AUTOMATIC AND TOTAL EXEMPTION

Eligible public :

➤ Scholarship students

- students with a need-based grant
- students with a scholarship from the French State

In order to benefit from an automatic exemption, the following documents have to be provided as appropriate :

- final scholarship award notification for the current academic year,
- or - conditional scholarship award notification for the current academic year,
- or - the final notification related to the previous year.

As regards the two last situations, it is imperative that you provide the final scholarship award notification for the current academic year on **November 15, 2025** at the latest.

If any of the aforementioned supporting documents cannot be provided just as registering, fees will be required and a refund will be possible upon presentation of a supporting document.

- **Students with a *Pupille de la Nation* status (war orphan status).**
- **Students on apprenticeship schemes**
- **Continuing education students under a French professionalization contract**

➤ PARTIAL AND AUTOMATIC EXEMPTION

- Students covered by an agreement with a foreign higher education institution that grants French students it admits an exemption from registration fees, or by a European or international mobility programme providing the same benefit. (*Fee exemption granted under reciprocal arrangements determined by an order of the French Minister responsible for Higher Education.*)

➤ DUTY EXEMPTION ON REQUEST

- Students benefiting from temporary protection
- Students who are:
 - ✓ Asylum seekers
 - ✓ Legally entitled to remain in France
 - ✓ Recognized refugees

➤ EXEMPTION BY INDIVIDUAL DECISION

☛ Upon registration

In accordance with the decision of the Grenoble INP Institute of Engineering's Board on July 9th, 2026, non-EU students may benefit from partial or total exemption in the following cases:

➔ Partial exemption

- ✓ students enrolled in a preparatory program (PEIP) at Polytech Grenoble,
- ✓ students enrolled in a Bachelor's degree at Grenoble IAE - INP, UGA,
- ✓ students enrolled in a Master's program at Grenoble INP - Ensimag, UGA,
- ✓ students re-registering for the 1st time for non-validation of skills, including international students,
- ✓ students enrolled for a gap year: partial exemption from the reduced rate of Community fees,
- ✓ students with dual enrolment at the Institut polytechnique de Grenoble: partial exemption for the second enrolment, at the reduced rate of Community fees,

- ✓ students in the Engineering program who have been deferred for non-validation of international competence on first re-enrolment,
- ✓ students who must be re-register to finalize their end-of-studies internship (Engineering or Master's program), which is organized over 2 consecutive academic years, with the corresponding thesis to be defended before December 15 of the year of re-enrollment.

➔ **Partial exemption (reducing differentiated tuition fees, where applicable, to the full rate of tuition fees applicable to Community students) OR total exemption, depending on cooperation agreements**

- ✓ Students enrolled in a French establishment other than the Institut polytechnique de Grenoble, in application of an agreement concluded with the Institut polytechnique de Grenoble or one of the Institut polytechnique de Grenoble's training components.
- ✓ Students following a course of study under an agreement between the Institut polytechnique de Grenoble and another establishment, in accordance with article L. 123-7-1 of the French Education Code.

➔ **Total exemption**

If one of the following situations can be proved, students will benefit from a total exemption :

- ✓ disabled student $\geq 80\%$,
- ✓ students on study leave from the start of the academic year,
- ✓ students from conflict-affected areas who are awaiting refugee status, including, in particular, students from Gaza, Iran, Lebanon, Pakistan, and Ukraine,
- ✓ students on an incoming exchange program as part of a European or international program for international exchange students,
- ✓ students re-registering for a 2nd year due to non-validation of skills, including international students, students in the engineering cycle who have been deferred for failure to validate international competence - on second re-enrolment,
- ✓ engineering students who have not achieved level B2 in English,
- ✓ students in the Master's program who have not validated level B2 in English when this condition is required,
- ✓ on-French-speaking international students in the Engineering program who have not passed level B2 in French when this condition is required.

➔ **After registration : by decision of the President of the Grenoble Institute of Technology**

Given the very high level of demand and the strict eligibility criteria, and despite its strong commitment to widening access to higher education and its policy of internationalising its programmes, Grenoble INP – UGA will only be able to grant a very **limited** number of requests for registration fee waivers and social assistance.

Therefore, **it is essential to seek information about sources of financial assistance available outside the institution** (scholarships, student bank loans, etc.).

➤ **REFUND**

▶ **Students who give up their registration before the start of the course**

The refund of fees is automatic when the student gives up her·his registration before the start of the course.

▶ **Students who give up their registration after the start of the course**

The students who give up their registration after the start of the academic year can submit a request for a refund of fees, separately from their resignation letter, according to the criteria defined by the Executive Board dated December 13, 2012, specifically :

- ▶ personal circumstances of the student (or her·his family), forcing her·him to stop her·his studies,
- ▶ medical condition of the student (or one of her·his close family members), justifying the stop of the training,
- ▶ situation of the student forced by an administrative or legal decision to be no more present at the course (apart from a disciplinary sanction),
- ▶ registration at an institution other than a French Public Higher Education Institution,
- ▶ a student who has found a stable employment.

The request for a refund is submitted to the decision of the President of the Grenoble Institute of Technology and the potential refund will be subject to the following conditions :

If the resignation occurs :

- before the start of classes, the refund covers the whole fees (except administrative costs whose amount is specified in the yearly order setting fees).
- between the start of classes and December 15, the refund is partial and is equal to 8/12th of the registration amount (except administrative costs whose amount is specified in the yearly order setting fees).

In any case:

1. Requests for refunds must be submitted before December 15 of the current academic year. After this date, no refund request will be accepted.

Refund requests for registration fees submitted by students who withdraw from their registration after the start of classes are subject to a decision by the President, in accordance with the general criteria established by the Executive Board. If a refund of registration fees is granted, which may be partial, an amount of €23 will be retained by the institution to cover the administrative procedures required for registration.

2. In any case, if the refund is granted, it will occur only on next January.

▶ **Transfer of a registration towards another institution**

In the case of a transfer of a registration towards another institution, the refund of fees is automatic.

A sum of money, whose amount is set by a ministerial order, remains acquired to the institution by way of handling charges.

On the other hand, none refund is granted if the transfer occurs at the end of the 1st semester.

- The *Identifiant National Etudiant* (INE) is your national student reference number.
 - ✓ *Baccalaureate* holders : the number features on the French *Baccalaureate* transcript (BEA),
 - ✓ Students previously registered at a French Higher Education Institution : the number features on the last student ID card
- STUDENT NUMBER (8 digits, only for reregistration)

The student number is the number featuring on last year's *Grenoble Institute of Technology* student ID card.
- FIRST REGISTRATION WITH A FRENCH HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION (Year following the award of the *Baccalaureate graduation*)

It is necessary to specify the year of the first registration at a French Higher Education Institution. This includes : *Intensive Foundation Degree – Entrance exam preparatory class within the institution applied to – Bachelor's Degree – University Institute of Technology – Higher National Diploma (HND) – Engineering School – Business School – Catholic Institutes – Private Universities – Teacher Training University Institutes*
- UNREGISTERED STUDENT (= AUDITEUR LIBRE)

Auditeurs Libres, i.e. Unregistered Students, attend a programme without sitting an examination, have to enclose the supporting document according to which the School's Director allow them to do so.
- CONCURRENT REGISTRATION WITH ANOTHER INSTITUTION

The *Grenoble Institute of Technology* being the main admission institution, the payment of the fees is required in their entirety.
- PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY DISABLING OR A DISABLING DISEASE :

Some adjustments may be necessary for the success of the studies and exams.

In order to enable the student concerned to benefit from measures tailored to her-his situation, it is necessary to :

 - contact the registrar's office of the school,
 - refer to the document entitled "1st formalities" enclosed to the registration form,
 - refer to the "Service Accueil Handicap de la Communauté Grenoble Alpes" (SAH) / Grenoble Alpes University Disability Office.

The informations provided are confidential. It must be specified if the institution is allowed to communicate anonymously about the situation of the student, especially to answer to ministerial surveys.
