REQUEST FOR UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE HOUSING

Students of foreign nationality whose duration of studies is at least one academic year

An agreement between Grenoble INP and the Crous of Grenoble allows students of foreign nationality registering for at least one academic year to be eligible for the allocation of accommodation in a student residence.

The number of places is limited. In order to be considered for accommodation by the Crous, the request must be made in accordance with the following timetables and procedures.



IMPERATIVE

whatever the type of demand

Inform Grenoble INP of your wish to be accommodated in a university residence (contact below)

AS SOON AS POSSIBLE and before July 20th, 2021

IDENTIFICATION

Create an account on the student life portal messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr

HOUSING DEMAND

With your ID user created on Mes Services

→ Submit a house application on the Crous https://trouverunlogement.lescrous.fr

From JULY 9th,2021

IMPERATIVE before entering the accomodation

▲ Having suscribed to the Visale guarantee https://www.visale.fr/

Free rental deposit without means tested for <u>under 30 years old students</u> - <u>Tutorial</u>
Accommodation requests from students over 30 years old will be taken into account but are not given priority.

PLEASE check your identity on the « visa-Visale » that vill be issued to you

Allocation of accommodation is conditioned to these steps subject to availability and on schedule



The visa-visale will be essential to allow your entry into the accomodation

- Admissions are effective from <u>September 1st</u>. You must have made the rent for the September month by September 10th at the latest. <u>Otherwise, the accommodation will be allocated to another student</u>
- If you are unable to occupy your accomodation from the month of September, you must promptly notify the residence.

 Rent remains due for the duration of the vacancy.

FIRST REQUEST PROCEDURE



Inform your school Student Affairs Department of your wish to be housed in a university residence

- 1. Create an account on messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr
- 2. Identify yourself on the platform <u>trouverunlogement.lescrous.fr/</u> with the ID user created on MesServices and file your housing whishes
- 3. File a Visale bond request on https://www.visale.fr/

READMISSION REQUEST

RENEWAL REQUEST

Inform the Grenoble INP Housing Department you have a room in a university residence scolarite.logement-etudiants@grenoble-inp.fr

- 1. You followed the Crous renewal procedure
- 2. File a new Visale bond request on https://www.visale.fr/ for 2021/2022

PLEASE NOTE The new « visa-visale » for 2021/2022 will be required to enter the accommodation and must be presented to your residence reception desk at the beginning of the school year

PLEASE NOTE a new allocation of accommodation is only possible if you are up to date in the payment of your rents

Housing proposal

If you are not known to the school service or the Grenoble INP housing deprtment, you will not be given priority for the allocation of accommodation



Student commitment form

After your entry into the accommodation, you will receive a student commitment form that you MUST sign and return to the Grenoble INP housing department
