

European universities and European Values

Summary

European values are at the heart of European University Networks. The latter have been created to achieve two main objectives: promoting common European values and boosting the quality of higher education in Europe. It shall be explained how unite! and other EUNs can contribute to the promotion of European values. **Unite!** focusing on technology, the main question is also to determine how European values allow the regulation, development or restriction of technical progress as well as interrogating the very idea of progress. To this end, an extended approach of European values will be adopted going beyond a purely legal perspective (rule of law, democracy and human rights) including citizenship, environmental concerns, heritage, culture, migrations or even solidarity.

In 1998, Constance CHEVALLIER-GOVERS obtained her PhD thesis on “Police cooperation in the EU” from the university of Paris 2. Nominated Associate Professor in the University of Paris 12 in 1999 she moved to the University of Grenoble in 2001.
